Important news about **parking for carers at Torbay Hospital** -

From September 2017 Carers will need to park in the barriered car parks, and take their tickets to get voided at various points (to include the Advice Point at the new front entrance, and Estates building) as well as existing Level 2 Outpatients, and Level 4 (main entrance) reception.

Any Carers who are already entitled to free parking (requiring treatments for certain illnesses) should use this method rather than be logged as Carers.

Carers can still park in un-barriered car parks at Totnes and Newton Abbot.

Currently, there is an unacceptable contrast between the quality of life and the opportunities available to children with disabilities and their families, compared to those without disabilities.
